Title: Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2021 – Lifesaving Officials Appointments (Version 1 – January 2021)

Summary: This circular contains the names of the Officials appointed for the 2021 Lifesaving events at the Australian Surf Life Saving Championships, together with all relevant reporting, briefing and other matters for notation by appointed Officials.

This document has been prepared with the best intentions based on current State Health Authority information regarding COVID-19 restrictions and related border movements. However, as has been noted over many months this information is constantly changing and as such all officials should be prepared to allow for some flexibility in their planning. SLSA will do their best to provide advance notice on the listed options and possible further amendments however, again, as has been witnessed over many months COVID-19 restrictions can be amended with little to no notice by the various State Health Authorities.

SLSA is actively working with QLD Health and the Sunshine Coast City Council to finalise the COVID Safe Plan for the Championships. Due to the dynamic nature of the COVID-19 pandemic, and related restrictions, SLSA cannot guarantee there will be no amendments to the event and/or the timetable of races leading into and during the Championships. All endeavours are being examined and discussed to keep the event as normal as possible however SLSA acknowledges that due to the COVID-19 pandemic there are likely to be restrictions in some form placed on the Championships.

Officials Dinner

Due to COVID-19 restrictions we are having to do something different this year. SLSA did not want to cancel the officials dinner as we want to be able to thank you for all your hard work, however due to COVID-19 restrictions we cannot host all officials in the officials' marquee at one time.

SLSA will be splitting the dinner over two nights and we ask you select which night best suits your availability. You may only attend one dinner and we ask that you carefully consider your choice prior to nominating as due to catering requirements you will not be permitted to change nights.

Once the capacity of each event has been reached you may be allocated to the remaining date.

Saturday 25th April 2021, 6pm – 9:30pm, Officials Marquee.

A formal invite will be sent to you with details of how to rsvp for these events.

We advise if you are officiating at Youth or Master's to attend option one, if you are officiating at Opens we advise you to attend option two.

Officials Awards Ceremony

As we did not host the Aussies last year, we will present the 2020 and 2021 Officials awards on Wednesday 21st April on the main stage in the Festival Zone.

Everyone is welcome to come attend this ceremony and we strongly encourage you to attend to celebrate and support your peers.
