Background

Powercraft Circular 29/20-21

- As noted in Circular 29/20-21 - Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2021- Powercraft Circular:
- Given the current environment and people's ability to travel due to COVID restrictions, it would be greatly appreciated if any volunteers who would like to do more shifts than their club is required to do, could you please email events@slsa.asn.au with their days of availability to help cover any holes that may appear in the roster in the lead up and duration of the championships.
- Further to the above, some clubs will struggle to fill their shifts and ask for help, please keep a close eye on the deputy roosting system to be engaged to assist, or alternatively pass on your name and details to the events team at events@slsa.asn.au for SLSA to distribute your details to clubs who may require assistance.

Fatigue Management

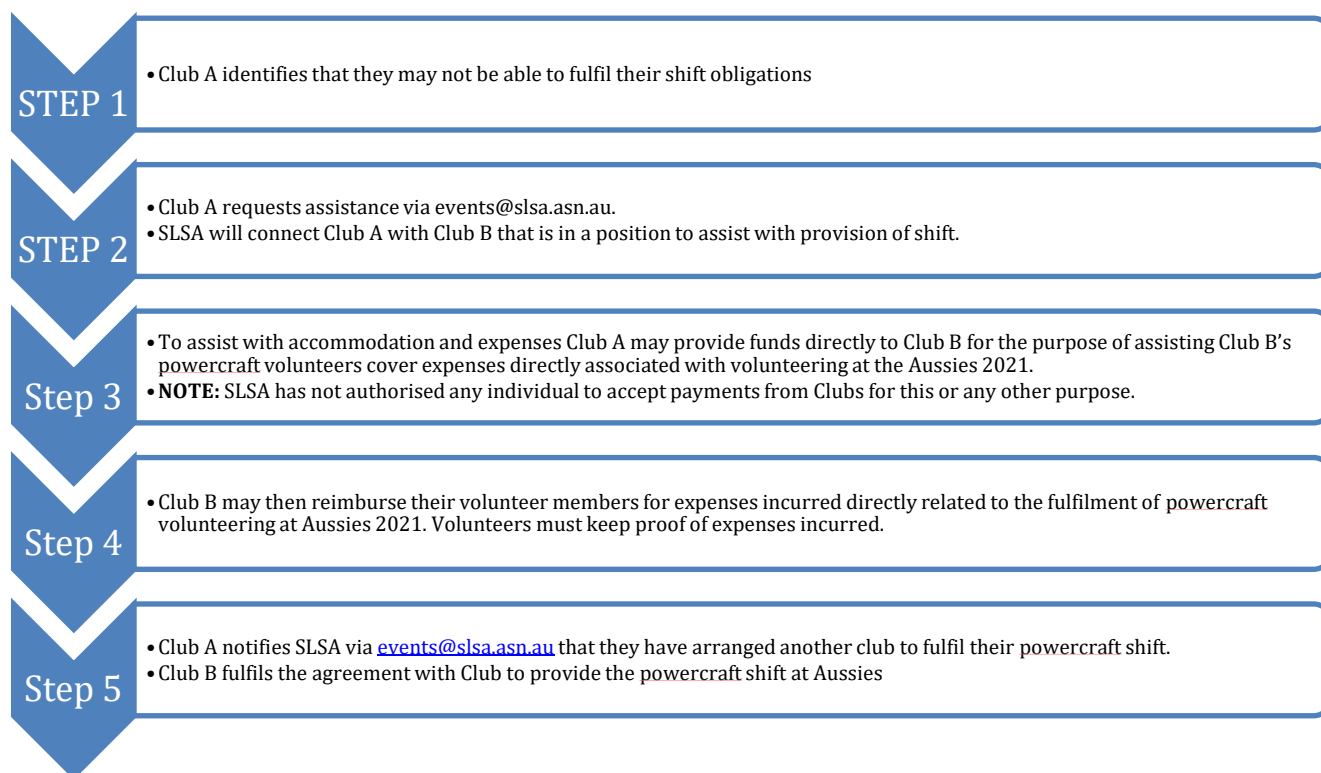
- Fatigue Management is identified in the Aussies 2021 Safety Operations Manual within the Event Risk Management Plan – Risk ID 22.
- Fatigue Management also is identified on P144 of the Aussies 2021 Safety Operation Manual.
- The Powercraft Roster and system contained within Circular 29/20-21 - Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2021- Powercraft Circular are also important tools for managing fatigue for volunteers operating powercraft at the event.

Club to Club – Powercraft Shift Assistance

- As specified in the Circular 29/20-21 - Australian Surf Life Saving Championships 2021- Powercraft Circular, SLSA is conscious that some clubs may struggle to fulfil their shift obligations and therefore wishes to clarify how clubs may engage other clubs to assist in the fulfilment of obligations.

Additional Notes

- Under no circumstances are individual members to accept payments from clubs of which that they are not a member.
- Clubs may only provide subsidises for reasonable expenses incurred directly as a result of volunteering activities associated with the Aussies 2021.
- Proof of these expenses must be provided back to the SLSC.
- Volunteers must not accept payments or subsidies from individuals for any reason.
- Any member or club found to be operating outside of this process may be subject to disciplinary proceeding.
